The traditional format is:

Lasagna Hints:

1. 90 oz Stouffer's Meat Lasagna (Sams or Target are good places to find it)
2. Label says to cook frozen 1 hr. 45 min., actual cooking time is closer to 2 hrs., best to check it with a knife in middle at 2 hrs.
3. Label says to tent lid. Actually, ***just vent one edge of cover, otherwise it dries out too much.***
4. Label says to remove lid last 15-20 minutes. Please ***DO NOT REMOVE LID.*** This bakes the cheese on top and makes it hard to cut. Just leave the lid vented until done.
5. Please transport the lasagna in an old towel and place in an ice chest with your name on it (so you can get it back after the event)) Stays warmer longer.
6. The lasagna is really too bulky for the aluminum container so try baking it on a cookie sheet. If you bring your cookie sheet to the banquet, please put your name on it.
7. **DO NOT BRING UTENSILS TO THE BANQUET. THEY WILL BE LOST FOREVER. THIS IS A PROVEN SCIENTIFIC FACT.**
